Investigations are closed with a decision, which can include: unsubstantiated, services not recommended, services recommended, in need of services, and substantiated.

A case decision of "in need of services" (usually connected to neglect or dependency cases) or substantiated will typically prompt the Department of Social Services (DSS) to open a "family in-home" services case or petition the court to take children into custody (foster care).

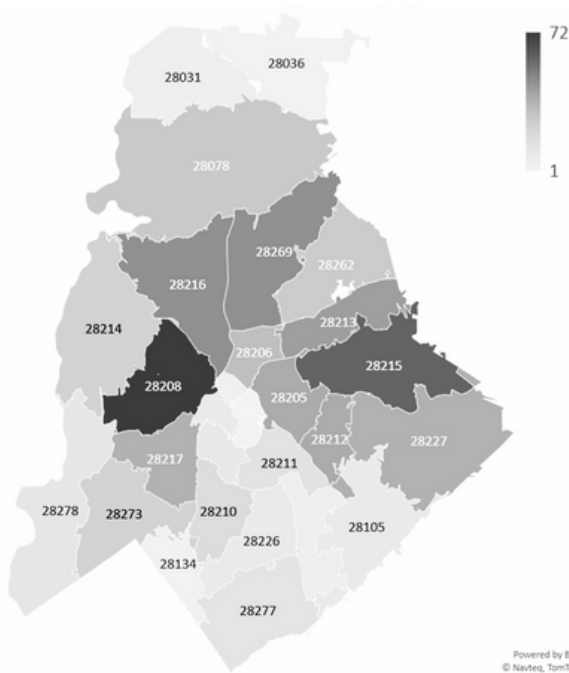
